

**Amendment No 3 to the Letter of Agreement (LoA)
Between the World Meteorological Organization (WMO)
And
the Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP)
Concerning Fiji NCOF/NSC and Stakeholder Consultation**

Ref.: 09134/2019-14 DRA

This amendment is made to the Letter of Agreement signed 20 December 2017, and the Amendment No 2 signed on 23 November 2018, between WMO and SPREP concerning the Fiji NCOF/NSC and Stakeholder Consultation. The amendment is required due to unforeseen circumstance that have caused delays in the implementation of the Agreements point 1.2 b) "(...) organization of stakeholder consultation workshop for the development of strategic plan for Fiji Meteorological Service (FMS)".

It is mutually understood and agreed by the undersigned Parties to amend the following clauses of the LoA:

3. Reporting

3.1 The Recipient Organization shall submit to WMO a detailed statement of expenditure incurred in undertaking the activities in paragraph 1.2 above, under the format as per the annex to this Agreement and certified to its correctness by the Head of Financial Services of the Recipient Organization, with originals or validated copies of supporting documents, by **31 March 2019**

3.2 Should the actual expenditure incurred be less than the amount provided by WMO, the Recipient Organization shall reimburse the unspent funds to WMO, by **31 March 2019** to the following account:

Is amended as follows:

3.1 The Recipient Organization shall submit to WMO a detailed statement of expenditure incurred in undertaking the activities in paragraph 1.2 above, under the format as per the annex to this Agreement and certified to its correctness by the Head of Financial Services of the Recipient Organization, with originals or validated copies of supporting documents, by **31 March 2020**.

3.2 Should the actual expenditure incurred be less than the amount provided by WMO, the Recipient Organization shall reimburse the unspent funds to WMO, by **31 March 2020** to the following account:

7. Entry into force

7.1 The present Agreement shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties and shall remain in force until **31 March 2019** and for such a period thereafter as is necessary for all matters relating to any of its provision to be settled

Is amended as follows:

7.1 The present Agreement shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties and shall remain in force until **31 March 2020** and for such a period thereafter as is necessary for all matters relating to any of its provision to be settled.

This amendment shall be construed in connection with, and as part of the LoA. All other terms and conditions set forth in the MoU, except as herein amended are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
