### Amendment #1

The Amendment # 1 is required to

- 1) Enable the Annex II of the Memorandum of Understanding signed between SPREP and MEIDECC to facilitate the implementation of the 'Committing to Sustainable Waste Actions in the Pacific' (SWAP) Project which was signed on the 17 January 2023 to extend the end date from 31 December 2023 to 31 December 2024

In all other respects, the parties confirmed the Agreement.

The Memorandum of Understanding and Annex II is amended as follows:

<b>Clause 6 – Operational Provisions</b>	Delete the paragraph that reads as follows:  "iii) The duration of this MOU shall be for five years, renewable for such further period as may be agreed between the Parties."  And replace with the new paragraph as follows:  "iii) The Parties agree to renew this MOU under Amendment #1, for an additional period of five years, renewable for such further period as may be agreed by both Parties."
