PROJECT COOPERATION AGREEMENT

for a

GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT FACILITY Full-sized Project

BETWEEN: The United Nations Environment Programme (hereinafter referred to as, “UNEP”) and represented by its Director of Industry and Economy Division. UNEP is an international inter-governmental organization established by the General Assembly of the United Nations, having its office at P.O. Box 30552, 00100, Nairobi, Kenya.

AND: The Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP), (hereinafter referred to as the “Executing Agency”), an intergovernmental organization under Apia and SPREP conventions represented by its Director General and having its office at Vailima, Apia, Samoa.

hereinafter collectively referred to as, “the Parties”,

ON: Full-sized Project, “Implementing Sustainable Low and Non-Chemical Development in SIDS (ISLANDS)”.

Pursuant to Clause 66 of the Project Cooperation Agreement (PCA/2021/June) of 23 July 2021 on execution of the Full-sized Project, “Implementing Sustainable Low and Non-Chemical Development in SIDS (ISLANDS)”, between UNEP and the SPREP, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement.

WHEREAS on 23 July 2021, UNEP and the Executing Agency concluded a PCA (hereinafter referred to as the, “original PCA”);

The purpose of this Amendment (hereinafter referred to as, “Amendment 1”) is to request UNEP’s consideration and concurrence to a No-Cost Extension of the PCA Agreement.

WHEREAS the SPREP has submitted to UNEP progress and expenditure reports and is required to continue to submit further progress reports, expenditure reports and the final reports;

WHEREAS the Parties now intend to conclude the present Agreement in order to complete all agreed pending activities as per the revised work plan, appended as **Annex 4**.

1. General provision

1.1 Clause 5 of the Agreement, is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

This Agreement shall come into force upon signature by the Parties, being effective from the date of the latest signature, and shall remain in force until **30 June 2028** after the last obligation of the Parties lapse, unless terminated earlier pursuant to clauses 52 to 63 of this Agreement. However, project effectiveness shall be the date of receipt by the Executing Agency of the first instalment of funds.

2. Entry into force

This Amendment Number 1 shall enter into force upon the date of the last signature of the approving officials below.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain valid and unchanged.

This Amendment shall be appended to the Agreement and shall be construed an integral part of it.
